4. Balloons come in packs of 5 and 10 . Sophie has 35 balloons. How many of each pack does she have? Are there other ways to do it?
5. Joe and Salim are sharing some sweets. They have 5 packs of sweets, and once they have shared them they have 15 sweets each. How many sweets are in each packet?
