

Curriculum- Week 1

Science-

I would like you to investigate and research sedimentary, igneous and metamorphic rocks. These are natural rocks. What are they made from? Where are they found? What are they used for? etc. I have attached a PowerPoint to help you.

Level 1- Choose 1 type of rock and write some simple sentences about it.

Level 2/Level 3- Write a short paragraph for each rock type. Include as much information and examples as you can. Remember not to just copy the information down, rewrite it in your own words.

RE-

I would like you to write a prayer of 'Hope' to God. Think about what you hope for yourself in the future and what you hope for you loved ones. We are living in a different world at the moment so you may want include what you hope will change in the world. Remember to start your prayer with 'Dear God' and end it with 'Amen'.

Art-

You're going to create a silhouette. Using either paint, crayons, pastels etc. create either a sunset or sunrise background. Think about the colours you see and how they change. Then using black, it can either be paint or black card, design your silhouette. It could be of an animal, city or transport etc.

Geography-

Moving on from sketching maps you're going to look at using keys. Using the PowerPoint to help you, design a simple map and include a key. Remember to include the features.

Level 1- Using the PowerPoint and information sheet; create your own map including a title and some symbols and a key. The map can either be made up or somewhere you know very well.

Level 2/ Level 3- Using the PowerPoint and information sheet; create your own map including all 7 of the features. The map can either be made up or somewhere you know very well.

History-

Thinking about The Great Fire of London, I would like you to research it and write a recount of events. Remember recounts need to be in chronological order.

Level 1- Cut and stick the sequencing cards in order or write them down.

Level 2/ Level 3- Using the PowerPoint to help write a recount of events. Try to avoid using 'and' and 'then' as much as you can.

French-

Write a small simple conversation you would have if you met somebody new.
Think about how you would say hello or hi, ask their name and if they are ok.
